(15) All notices required or permitted to be given by this lease shall be deemed to be properly given if delivered in writing personally or sent by registered mail to the Lessor or to the Lessee as the case may be at the addresses set forth above, or to such other address as may be furnished by either party to the other in writing. (16) If Lessee holds over the premises herein described beyond the determination by limitation of the term herein created, or any extension thereof, or any renewal of this lease pursuant to the terms hereof, without first having renewed or extended this lease by written agreement, such holding over shall not be considered as a renewal or extension of this lease except upon a month-to-month basis.

(17) Lessor covenants that Lessee on paying said rent and performing the covenants aforesaid, shall and may peaceably and quietly have, hold and enjoy the said leased property for the term aforesaid, subject to the provisions hereof.
