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POWER OF ATTORNEY

The power and authority given herein is general and unlimited, but it especially includes the right, power and authority to the said attorney in my name and stead to ask, demand, sue for, levy, recover and receive all such sums of money, debts, rents, goods, wares, dues, accounts, or other demands whatsoever, which are or shall be due, ewing or payable to me or detained from me in any manner or ways or means whatspever.

This Power of Attorney shall not be effected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing his own estate.

My Power of Attorney shall have the right to deposit to and withdraw from any tanking account, savings account, or other type depositor from any bank, savings & loan association or financial institution, where I may have monies, deposits, accounts or credits. Likewise, my Power of Attorney shall have complete control over my stocks and bonds in like manner being able to sell or buy, trade or exchange the same as she may see fit.

My Power of Attorney shall have the right to handle, care for, control, sell and dispose of any property, real or personal, that I may two and to purchase for me any property, real or personal, and to execute decis of conveyance.

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
