a good warranty deed, free of liens, assessments or encumbrances of any sort which would render the title less than a marketable fee simple one as soon as the mortgage affecting these premises is paid in full or within three (3) years of the date hereof or as soon as the buyers begin to construct a permanent dwelling place on these premises, whichever event occurs first; should any defect arise during the title search, other than the mortgage noticed herein, or if any violations of zoning or building ordinances are discovered by the Purchasers, the Seller hereby agrees to remedy them in order to comply with the terms of this contract, and if he fails to do so within thirty (30) days after written notice thereof, the Purchasers shall have the option of declaring this contract null and void.
