FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is are exclusively religious, charitable, educational, and recreational; to conduct religious services, ceremonies, and schools; and to exercise certain moral and spiritual and charitable funcitons consistent with Christian doctrine of the Baptist Discipline; and to cooperate with other groups with like concern. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Deacons and Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific pruposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as siad Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
