KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, LILLIE ANNETTE PHILLIPS

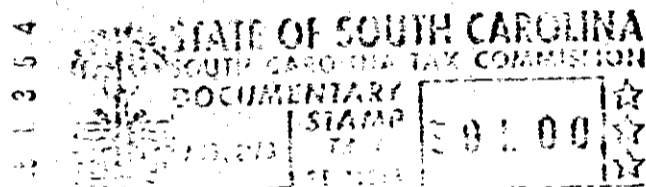
in consideration of Two Hundred Seventy-Five & No/100 (\$275.00) ----- Dollars,
