Ball and George I. Wike, Jr., their heirs and assigns forever,

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, west of the Fork Shoals Road on the Georgia Road about 12 miles south of the City of Greenville, containing 162.30 acres, more or less, being known as a portion of the home place of the late J.
