TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, the City of Greenville is authorized to levy taxes and assess property within the limits of said city for taxation, and upon default in the payment thereof, to issue under the hand and seal of the Clerk of the City Council of the City of Greenville an execution directed to some officer designated for the collection of delinquent taxes, requiring and commanding him to levy the same by distress and sale of so much of the defaulting taxpayer's estate, real, personal, or both, as may be sufficient to satisfy the taxes and charges thereon so levied and assessed: and further that said officer may take possession of such property and after due advertisement, sell and dispose of the same as in such cases provided by law, make titles thereto and put the purchaser in possession, and

WHEREAS, there appears on the Tax Books of said City for the fiscal year(s) 1976 and 1977 certain real estate consisting of:

assessed in the name of Pearl Thompson (Life Estate). The taxes, penalties and assessments thereon amount to One hundred four and 56/100 (\$104.56) Dollars;
