7. The property subject to this right of first refusal is described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the Southeastern side of Hood Road, containing 19.89 acres, more or less, as shown on plat of Property of George L. Jones Estate, dated December 9, 1963, prepared by John A. Simmons and recorded in the R.M.C.
