McBrayer to sign the legal deeds and any other legal papers necessary to transfer title on behalf of the NORTHMINSTER PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH and THE GOSPEL ASSOCIATION; and

WHEPEAS, The Presbytery of the Piedmont of The Presbyterian Church in the United States has taken appropriate action according to its order of government to dissolve the NORTHMINSTER PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH and to receive title to the Church's property;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that MORTH-MINSTEP PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH, Greenville, South Carolina, and THE GOSPEL ASSOCIATION, a religious corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in consideration of the premises and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto THE PRESBYTERY OF THE PIEDMONT, a South Carolina religious corporation organized for the purposes of holding title to property for the benefit of The Presbytery of the Piedmont of the Presbyterian Church in the United States, its successors and assigns forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, together with improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the northeastern side of Hillcrest Drive in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No. 16, Block E of Subdivision known as Highland Terrace, a plat of which is recorded in Plat Book D, Pages 238 and 239, Greenville County R.M.C. Office, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
