It is the finding of this Court that each of the Defendants in this case is in Default at this time.

It is the further finding of this Court that the Deeds purporting to convey away the interest of Frank Luther Mathis, Sr., dated January 14, 1974, to Marilyn W. Mathis, which is filed in the office of Register of Mesne Conveyances of Greenville County, Book 992, Page 152, and the Deed from Marilyn W. Mathis to Hazel Ruth Williams, the 20th day of March, 1978, which is filed in Book 1075, Page 682, the Register of Mesne Conveyances, Greenville County, and the Deed of the 24th of October, 1978, from Hazel Ruth Williams to Marilyn W. Mathis, which is filed in the Office of Mesne Conveyances of Greenville County, in Deed Book 1090 at Page 597, were transfers made in an effort to hide assets of the Defendant Frank Luther Mathis.

It is the further finding of this Court that such transfers were fraudulently made.

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
