WHEREAS, PLEASANT GROVE BAPTIST CHURCH, Greer, South Carolina, desirous of making provisions for the adequate maintenance, upkeep, beautification and perpetual care of its cemetery located adjacent to the church, and having certain funds available to be applied toward that objective, by its duly authorized and acting Representatives, does hereby establish a Trust Fund with a Goal of Twenty Thousand and 00/100 (\$20,000.00) Dollars to achieve said purposes and objectives.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that in consideration of promises, the love and affection borne by the contributors to this fund herein for PLEASANT GROVE BAPTIST CHURCH, and the adjoining Cemetery, We, the Undersigned Representatives of PLEASANT GROVE BAPTIST CHURCH, do hereby create an Endowment Fund with a Goal of Twenty Thousand and 00/100 (\$20,000.00) Dollars for the purposes hereinafter expressed, and by this instrument do convey the said endowment in Trust to Woodrow Copeland, Milford Burnett and James D. Suddeth, and their successors in Office, in Trust, nevertheless for the purposes and subject to the Control and limitations as hereinafter set forth:

1. It is specifically understood by this instrument that the Trustees above named, and their successors in office, shall receive the existing funds now available for the upkeep, preservation, and perpetual care of the Church Cemetery and receive and accept any additional funds donated to this Trust Fund for the sole benefit of the PLEASANT GROVE BAPTIST CHURCH, Greer, S.C., and they shall have, by these presents, authority to invest, loan, or deposit said funds in a judicious manner, and collect all interests or income from the same for the purpose of protecting and maintaining the said Cemetery at the above Church, reporting annually to the regular appointed Conference session of the said church of their activities and collections, which said interests or income derived from the above Trust
