The subject property is a portion of the property devised to Houston Lindsey and Carl Lindsey under Item III of the Will of the late Amanda T. Lindsey as will appear by reference to Apartment 762 File 18 in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County. Such devise contained the following attempted limitation:

"This land is not to be sold, but is to remain in their family."

This attempted limitation or restraint was held to be invalid and unenforceable in a subsequent declaratory judgment action in the case of Ansel L. Pruitt, et al vs. Annie G. Pruitt, et al, which is filed in Judgment Roll K-11,013 in the Office of the Greenville County Clerk of Court.
