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continued from original) To erect dwellings, apartment houses and other buildings, private or public, of all kinds, and to sell or rent the same. To lay out, grade, pave, and dedicate roads, streets, avenues, highways, alleys, courts, paths, walks, parks and playgrounds. To buy, sell, mortgage, exchange, lease, let, hold for investment or otherwise use and operate real estate of all kinds, improved or unimproved, and any rights or interests therein;

- 3) to acquire by purchase, lease, gift, devise or otherwise, and to own, use, hold, sell, convey, exchange, lease, mortgage, work, improve, develop, divide, and otherwise handle, deal in and dispose of real estate, real property and any interest or right therein, whether as principal, agent, broker, or otherwise, and to manage, operate, service, equip, furnish, alter, and keep in repair dwellings, apartment houses, hotels, office buildings, and real and personal property of every kind, nature and description, whether as principal, agent, broker, or otherwise, and generally do any thing and every thing necessary and proper and to the extent permitted by law in connection with the owning, managing, leasing, and operating of real and personal property of any and all kinds;
- 4) to acquire, own, hold, improve, develop, operate, exploit, sell, convey, assign, lease, exchange, transfer, dispose of, pledge, mortgage, grant security interests in, deal in and loan or borrow money upon, alone or in conjunction with others, real and personal property, tangible and intangible, of every kind, character and description, of any interest therein, and all kinds and forms of securities, shares of capital stock, scrip, bonds, debentures, coupons, mortgages, notes, bill of exchange, acceptances, assignments, accounts, fees, evidences of indebtedness, obligations, trust certificates, interim receipts, warrants and certificates issued or created by or being claimed against any corporation, association, partnership, syndicate, entity or person or governmental, municipal, or political subdivision, district or authority;
- 5) to engage in any other lawful activity, including but not limited to, construction, manufacturing, raising, or otherwise producing and repairing, servicing, storing or otherwise caring

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
