

(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by

these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said LINDA W. SHIFLET, her heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Bulter Township, City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot Number 132, as shown on a plat prepared by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, dated May of 1933, entitled "East Lynne Addition", recorded in Plat Book H, at Page 220, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Aniwetauk Street, (Formerly Johnson Street) at the joint front corner of Lots Number 131 and 132, and running thence with the line of Lot Number 131, South 61-10 East 150 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot Number 136; thence with the line of Lot Number 136 South 28-50 West 50 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Number 132, 135, 136 and 137; thence with the line of Lots Number 135, 134 and 133 North 61-10 West 150 feet to an iron pin on the southeastern side of Aniwetauk Street (Formerly Johnson Screec, East 50 feet to the point of beginning. (15) 519 - 257 - 4-4 (Formerly Johnson Street); thence with the southeastern side of said street North 28-50

This being the same lot of land conveyed to Odell Floyd Littleton and John Floyd by deed of Lillie F. Stowe dated the 12th day of June, 1979, and recorded in the Clerk of Court's Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 1104 at Page 622.
