REAL PROPERTY AGREEMENT

For a consideration of such loans and indebtedness as shall be made by or become due to the Bank of Travelers Rest hereinafter referred to as "Bank" it is to or from the undersigned, jointly or severally, and until all of such loans and indebtedness have been paid in full, or until twenty one years following the death of the last survivor of the undersigned, whichever first occurs, the undersigned, jointly and severally, promise and agree:

2. Without the prior written consent of Bank, to refrain from creating or permitting any lien or other encumbrance (other than those presently existing) to exist on, and from transferring, selling, assigning or in any manner disposing of, the real property described below, or any interest therein; and
3. Hereby assign, transfer and set over to Bank, its successors and assigns, all monies now due and hereafter becoming due to the undersigned, as rental, or otherwise, and howsoever for or on account of that certain real property situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, described as follows:

All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 2 on plat of Northside Heights, recorded in Plat Book MV at Page 89, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Pine Knoll Drive, at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 1, N. 75-02 W. 201.8 feet to iron pin; thence N. 6-40 E. 95 feet to iron pin on Northside Circle; thence with said Northside Circle, S. 81-55 E. 184.8 feet to iron pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Northside Circle and Pine Knoll Drive, S. 36-27 E. 28.1 feet to iron pin; thence with Pine Knoll Drive, S. 08-55 W. 95 feet to the point of beginning.

and hereby irrevocably authorize and direct all lessors, executors, holders and others to pay to Bank, all rent and all other monies whatsoever and whatsoever becoming due to the undersigned, or any of them, and howsoever for or on account of said real property, and hereby irrevocably appoint Bank, as attorney in fact, with full power and authority, in the name of the undersigned, or in his or her name, to endorse and negotiate checks, drafts and other instruments received in payment of, and to receive, receipt for and to enforce payment, by virtue of either one, of all said rents and sums; but agrees that Bank shall have no obligation to do, or to perform or discharge any obligation, duty or liability of the undersigned in connection therewith.

4. That if default be made in the performance of any of the terms hereof, or if any of said rental or other sums be not paid to Bank when due, Bank, at its discretion, may declare the entire remaining unpaid principal and interest of any obligation or indebtedness then remaining unpaid to Bank to be due and payable forthwith.

5. That Bank may and is hereby authorized and permitted to cause this instrument to be recorded at such time and in such places as Bank, in its discretion, may elect.

6. Upon payment of all indebtedness of the undersigned to Bank this agreement shall be and become void and of no effect, and nothing shall apply to and bind the undersigned, their heirs, legatees, devisees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns, and more to the benefit of Bank and its successors and assigns. The affidavit of any officer or department manager of Bank concerning any part of said indebtedness to remain unpaid shall be and constitute conclusive evidence of the validity, effectiveness and continuing force of this agreement and any person may and is hereby authorized to rely thereon.
