


BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeasterly edge of the right of way for U.S. Highway No. 25 and running thence with the line of "Avalon Estates "S. 52-54 E. 504.47 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of property now or formerly of Frontier Electronics, Inc., the following courses and distances: S. 19-33 W. 111.75 feet, thence S. 7-48 W. 154 feet, thence S. 12-25 W. 62.89 feet to an iron pin on the Northeastern edge of the right of way for U.S. Highway No. 25; thence with the edge of said right of way, the following courses and distances: N. 37-09 W. 100 feet, thence N. 36-00 W. 100 feet, thence N. 30-55 W. 100 feet, thence N. 28-03 W. 100 feet, thence N. 24-40 W. 100 feet, thence N. 21-40 W. 100 feet, thence N. 18-13 W. 95 feet and thence N. 16-16 W. 15.8 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the same identical tract of land conveyed to the grantors herein, Marion W. Fore, Jr. and Elizabeth F. Rycoft n/k/a Caroline F. Poon, by deed of Furman University recorded in the RYC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 1012 at page 396 on December 30, 1974.
