- B. In the event it is determined in the manner provided in this

  Declaration that the condominium property shall not be reconstructed

  after casualty, the condominium will be terminated and the condominium

  documents revoked, unless the Act shall have been amended to allow

  continuation of the condominium in such circumstances and corresponding

  amendments to this Declaration shall have been effected. The determination

  not to reconstruct after casualty resulting in termination of the condominium shall be evidenced by a certificate of any two of the officers of the

  Association certifying as to facts effecting the termination, which certificate

  shall become effective upon being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville

  County, South Carolina.
- C. After termination of the condominium, the rights of the residence owners and their respective mortgagees and lienees shall be determined in the manner provided in paragraph E of Appendix Two of this Declaration.
- XIX. COVENANTS RUNNING WITH THE LAND AND ENCROACHMENTS. A11 provisions of the condominium documents shall be construed to be covenants running with the land, and with every part thereof and interest therein, including but not limited to every residence and the appurtenances thereto: and every residence owner and claimant of the land or any part thereof or interest therein, and his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns shall be bound by all of the provisions of the condominium documents. An easement shall also exist for the maintenance, repair and replacement of any common facilities which may be attached to or encroach upon a Dwelling Unit. Further, minor encroachments resulting from the rebuilding of a Dwelling Unit or common facility which has been partially or totally destroyed, or due to settlement, or slight physical change, shall be permitted and an easement for said encroachments and maintenance, repair and replacement thereof shall exist. An easement shall also exist for changes in and/or additions to parking facilities as may be needed or required.
- XX. CONDOMINIUM DEEDS. The form of deed by which the Developer will convey a residence shall be substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "E".
- XXI. RESIDENCE TRANSFERS. any transfer of a residence shall include all appurtenances thereto whether or not specifically described,
