the singular and the plural as the facts or circumstances may indicate.

9. In the event Edward B. Reed is unable or unwilling to continue to serve as my attorney in fact, then I nominate, constitute and appoint his wife (and my daughter) Joanne Hampton Reed as successor attorney in fact and I hereby grant unto her as successor all of the power and authority granted unto my original attorney in fact, Edward B. Reed.

10. This power of attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal, Temple Irene Hampton, which renders the principal incapable of managing her own estate. It is the intent of the principal to create a durable power of attorney conferring upon her attorney in fact the power to act on behalf of the principal notwithstanding later disability or mental incompetence of the principal, pursuant to the authority of Section 32-13-10 of the 1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended.
