RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT

In consideration of the sum of money hereinafter set out and other good and valuable consideration, the adequacy and receipt of which is hereby acknowledged from the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, the undersigned, owner(s) of the premises described below, do hereby grant to the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company its licensees, agents, successors, assigns, and allied and associated companies, a right of way easement to construct, operate, maintain, add or remove such lines or systems of communications or related services as the grantee may require, consisting of:

- (1) poles, guys, anchors, aerial cables and wires;
- (2) buried cables and wires, cable terminals, markers, splicing boxes and pedestals;
- (3) conduits, manholes, markers, underground cables and wires;
- (4) and other amplifiers, boxes, appurtenances or devices.

upon over and under a strip of land Six (6) inches feet wide across the following lands in \_\_\_\_\_ County, State of \_\_\_\_\_ generally described as follows:

Easement entering the property in a northerly direction for a distance of seventeen hundred and sixty-three (1763) feet. (See sketch on back)

and, to the fullest extent the undersigned has the power to grant, if at all, over, along and under the roads, streets or highways adjoining or through said property.

All opened trenches and pits will be restored to prevent erosion.

The following rights are also granted: to allow any other person or company to attach wires or lay cable or conduit within the right of way for communications or electric power transmission or distribution; ingress and egress to said premises at all times; to clear the land and keep it cleared of all trees, underground or other obstructions within the easement area; to trim and cut and keep trimmed and cut all dead, weak, leaning or dangerous trees or limbs outside of the easement area which might interfere with or fall upon the lines or systems of communications or power transmission or distribution.

The receipt of One and No ~~no~~ Dollars (\$1.00) is hereby acknowledged by the undersigned. As further consideration for the within easement, Grantee agrees that, at its own expense, it will relocate the cable or wire operated within said easement if needed, to move and to take the above granted easement into Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, its successors and assigns forever.
