member of Association. Ownership of such interest shall be the sole qualification for such membership; no owner shall have more than one membership in each Association and there shall be only one vote per unit in such Association. Membership shall be appurtenant to and may not be separated from ownership of any lot which is subject to assessment. The Board of Directors may make reasonable rules regarding proof of ownership.

## ARTICLE V.

## VOTING RIGHTS.

<u>Section 1</u>. Classes. The Association shall have the following two classes of voting membership:

- (a) Class A. Class A members shall be all owners, with the exception of the Declarant. Class A members shall be entitled to one vote for each lot owned. When more than one person holds an interest in any lot all such persons shall be members. The vote for such lot shall be exercised as the owners thereof determine, but in no event shall more than one vote be cast with respect to any lot, and no fractional vote may be cast with respect to any lot.
- (b) Class B. The Class B member shall be the Declarant, and it shall be entitled to three (3) votes for each lot in which it holds a fee or undivided fee interest, provided that the Class B membership shall cease and be converted to Class A membership on the happening of either of the following events, whichever occurs earlier:
- (1) When the total votes outstanding in Class A membership equals the total votes outstanding in Class B membership; provided, however, that Class B membership shall be reinstated with all rights, privileges, and responsibilities, if, after conversion of the Class B membership to Class A membership as herein provided, additional lands are annexed to the Property by the Declarant in the manner provided in Article II of this Declaration, or
  - (2) on January 1, 1986
