TERUST AGREEMENT

This Agreement made this the 19th day of September, 1980 executed in duplicate between Caroline Burriss Moseley, hereinafter referred to as Trustor and The Citizens and Southern National Bank of South Carolina, hereinafter referred to as the Trustee.

ARTICLE I.

1. The Trustor hereby irrevocably assigns to the Trustee all her right, title and interest in and to that certain property, as shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto, as a part of this Trust. The Trustor reserves the right to make any additional property, real or personal, a part of this Trust by conveying the same in such manner as to legally vest title in the Trustee. The trust property shall consist of said assets, any life insurance policy or policies which shall irrevocably assigned to the Trustee, or shall revocably name the Trustee as beneficiary or shall be taken out by the Trustee on the life of the Trustor or anyone else, the proceeds of all the aforesaid life insurance policies, and any other assets of any kind or character whatever, which may hereafter be added to the trust by the Trustor or by anyone else, either during her or their lifetimes, or under the terms of her or their Will, or the terms of any trust established by her or by them, or in any other manner.

- 2. The Trustee hereby acknowledges receipt of the trust property listed in Schedule "A".
- 3. The Trustee is hereby vested with all right, title and interest in and to the trust property and is authorized and empowered to exercise and enjoy same, for the purposes of the trust herein created and as absolute owner of such property.
- 4. That the Trustee shall manage, invest and reinvest the trust property, and collect and receive any income therefrom and after deducting any and all necessary and proper expenses in connection with the administration of the trust, disburse said net income and corpus as follows:
- (a) The Trustee shall manage, invest and reinvest the corpus of this trust and collect and receive the income therefrom.
