THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 15th day of April. 1983, by and between WILSON M. DILLARD, hereinafter called "Grantor", and FRED J. COLLINS, JR., hereinafter called "Grantee";

WITNESSETH:

That Grantor, in consideration of One and No/100 (\$1.00)

Dollar and the premises, paid by Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does grant and convey unto Grantee, its heirs and assigns, subject to the limitations hereinafter described, the right to erect, construct, reconstruct, replace, maintain and use a sanitary sewer line, together with a right of way, on, along and in all of the hereinafter described tract of land lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

Being a strip of land fifteen (15) feet wide extending seven and one-half (7-1/2) feet on each side of the center line and being ninety-five and three-tenths (95.3) feet, more or less, in length.

The land of the Grantor over which said rights and easements are granted is a part of the property described in the deeds from J.E. Fleming, dated November 9, 1946 and November 10, 1954 respectively, recorded in the R.M.C.
