This agreement is made and entered into by and between

Article 1. The Buyer agrees to buy from the Seller, and the Seller agrees to sell to the Buyer, upon
the terms and conditions hereinafter stated, all the trees which have been marked or designated by the Seller or
his representatives, and which it is estimated will cut out approximately as follows: Approximately 23 acres as marked on the ground by orange surveyors tape and having approximate boundary: as shown on the attached aerial photo. The only trees to be cut within this boundary are Virginia Pine and Shortleaf Pine.
This sale area is located on a tract of land knows as C. Douglas Wilson Farm
in the County of Greenville , and State of South Carolina
from which the Seller is empowered to cut and/or sell forest products. Further description follows:
See attached aerial photo.
Article 2. The Buyer agrees to pay to the Seller the sum of Five thousand, three hundred twelve and no/10
(\$ 5,312.50) Dollars per boundary for the privilege of cutting and removing the above-described
trees. Payment shall be made in cash or equivalent, upon the signing to this agreement.
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Article 3. The Buyer further agrees to cut and remove the above-mentioned trees in accordance with the following conditions:
1. No trees shall be cut except those that have been marked or designated as follows: only Virginia Pine
and Shortleaf Pine within the boundary are to be sold, no hemlock, white pine or cedar shall be cut nor shall any hardwood be cut. 2. Unmarked merchantable trees, if cut or unnecessarily destroyed, shall be paid for at the rate of
Fifty and no/100 (\$ 50.00) Dollars per tree for each tree which is flagged with yellow tape or any tree outside the marked boundary.

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
