The Cooperative agrees that in locating or relocating and installing its structures and anchors, it will endeavor to take U advantage of roadways, streets, ditches, hedgerows, étc., so as to cause the least interference to the Grantor and his S use of said land; and that if, in the construction of said lines, facilities or structures, any injury is necessarily done to crops, fences, bridges or roads, it will repair or replace such fences, bridges or roads, and will pay the Grantor for injury to such crops.

Grantor reserves all other rights to said strip of land not inconsistent with the right and easement above set out, except that Grantor agrees that no wells shall be dug on said strip; that no septic tank, absorption pits, or underground storage tanks shall be placed on said strip; that no building or other structure shall be erected thereon; and that said strip shall not be used for burial grounds.
