- 5. To sign any instrument or legal document in my name pertaining to any of my business affairs, including income tax returns, questionnaires or reports.
- 6. To negotiate, make and execute such leases on my property as shall be deemed advisable; to demand, receive and collect all rents accruing under such leases and generally to do for me and in my name whatever is necessary and proper for the recovery of said rents.
- 7. To execute all necessary instruments, to carry out and perform any of the foregoing powers and to do any other acts requisite to the carrying out of such powers.


