expenses, costs, taxes or duties. Such taxes or duties shall not be charged against or recovered from any of the several beneficiaries either of this trust agreement or of the Grantor's estate, or the takers of such property. If the Trust created under this Article III is the named beneficiary of a death benefit distributed from a qualified pension or profit sharing plan, the property representing such distribution shall not be subject to be used by the Trustee to satisfy any debts, expenses, costs, taxes or duties as set forth above. The Trustee may purchase assets from the Grantor's estate at their fair market value and may loan money to the Grantor's estate for adequate collateral and at a reasonable rate of interest.

B. The Trustee shall pay the net income of this trust to, or apply the same for the benefit of the Grantor's wife, EULA F. BOST, during her lifetime, in at least quarterly installments. The Trustee may pay principal of this trust to or for the benefit of the Grantor's wife, during her lifetime. The Grantor's wife shall have the unrestricted power by specific reference in her Last Will and Testament to this power to appoint the then remaining principal and undistributed income of this trust to such person or persons, including her estate, as the Grantor's wife may desire. After the death of the Grantor's wife, or after the Grantor's death, if the Grantor's wife predeceases him, if not appointmented, the Trustee shall pay the net income of this trust in equal shares to, or apply the same for the benefit of, the following children of the Grantor, or their issue per stirpes: BENNETT W. BOST, LLOYD C. BOST, FLOYD P. BOST, NED W. BOST, RUTH BOST POSTON, ILLA MAE BOST ROEBUCK and MARGARET BOST JOHNSON. After the death of the Grantor's wife, if not appointmented, the Trustee may pay principal of this trust to, or apply the same for the benefit of BENNETT W. BOST, LLOYD C. BOST, FLOYD P. BOST, NED W. BOST, RUTH BOST POSTON, ILLA MAE BOST ROEBUCK and MARGARET BOST JOHNSON, or their issue; provided, however, no Trustee
