## AGREEMENT AFFECTING REAL ESTATE EXECUTED PURSUANT TO RULE 46, FEDERAL RULES OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, TITLE 18, UNITED STATES CODE

It is acknowledged by the undersigned that the property described
