The undersigned, Devenger Property Associates, a South Carolina General Partnership, the owner and developer of all numbered lots, access ways and common area of a subdivision known as Devenger Pointe Subdivision, Section I, as shown on plat of the same being recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book 9-F at Page 59, which plat was prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, dated March 25, 1983, does hereby impose on the numbered lots shown thereon, the same being Lots 6 through 31 inclusive and Lots 58 through 84 inclusive, access ways and common area, if any, the covenants and restrictions hereinafter set forth which shall be binding on all parties and all persons claiming under them until the 6th day of September, 2013, at which time said covenants shall be automatically extended for successive periods of ten (10) years unless by vote of a majority of the then owners of the lots it is agreed to change or abrogate said covenants in whole or in part. In such vote each lot shall be entitled to one vote and only one vote, irrespective of ownership.

If the undersigned, its successors or assigns, any lot owner in said subdivision or anyone else, shall violate or attempt to violate any of the covenants herein contained, it shall be lawful for any other person or persons owning any lot situated in said development or subdivision to prosecute any proceedings at law or in equity against the person or persons violating ar attempting to violate any such covenant and either to prevent him or them from doing or to recover damages or dues for such violation.

Invalidation of any one of these covenants shall in no wise affect any of the other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect.
