BEGINNING at a point in the center of a 17-inch brick wall, which point is 47 feet from the center of the western wall of the building on West Washington Street formerly owned by Ladson A. Mills and now owned by Rice-Cleveland Company, and running thence with the center of said 17-inch brick wall, S 20-05 W 96.15 feet to an iron pin in the northern line of a 10-foot alley; thence with said alley, N 69-32 W 46.7 feet to a point in the center of a 17-inch brick wall; thence with the center of said 17-inch brick wall N 19-55 E 96 feet to a point in the southern line of West Washington Street; thence with said West Washington Street, S 69-41 E 47 feet to the point of beginning.

Williams, and running thence through the center of said brick wall, S 20-05 W 96.15 feet to a point on the north side of a 10-foot alley; thence along the north side of said alley S 69-32 E 24 feet to a point in the outer edge of a brick wall; thence along the outer edge of said brick wall and continuing through the center of said wall from the point at which the building on the east adjoins said property, N 20-05 E a total of 96.2 feet ot a point in the center of said wall on the south side of West Washington Street; thence along the south side of West Washington Street N 69-41 W 24 feet to the point of beginning.
