under existing or future laws upon, or in respect to the

Trust Estate, or any money, property, or securities forming
a part thereof, shall be paid by the Trustees out of the Trust

Estate and the same shall constitute a charge thereon.

XX.

The Trustees of the trust created herein shall not be required to render any accounting, or reports to, any court, unless such accounting and reports are required by law, not-withstanding this direction of this Agreement and Declaration of Trust. The Grantor further directs that the Trustees shall at least once a year furnish to the principal beneficiary or beneficiaries of trust created hereunder a statement showing all investments, receipts and disbursements for the current year, and at the request of any beneficiary at any time, furnish to such beneficiary such other information concerning the financial condition of said trust as he or she may desire.

XXI.

References in this instrument to "Trustees" shall be """ deemed to include not only the original Trustees but also any successor Trustee or Trustees, and all powers and discretions vested in the Trustees shall be vested in and exercisable by any such successor Trustee or Trustees.
