

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the southeastern side of Hood Road containing 19.86 acres and being shown and delineated on a plat entitled "Property of American Hoechst Corporation" made July 27, 1983, by John A.
