

W. Altom by deed of Mary Frances Mason Hester (nee Mary Frances Mason) recorded June 14, 1960, in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 652 at Page 352.

Robert W. Altom died testate as a resident of Greenville County, S.C., on March 6, 1969, leaving a life estate in the above described property to his wife, Kate J. Altom, and the remainder at her death to his two daughters, Patricia A. Williams and Hazel A. Vance (see the records of the Probate Court for Greenville County, Apartment 1074, File 1). Kate J. Altom died testate as a resident of Greenville County, S.C., on June 26, 1981 (see the records of the Probate Court for Greenville County, Apartment 1667, File 11). Hazel A. Vance conveyed her interest in said property to the grantor herein by deed recorded January 12, 1982, in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 1161 at Page 31.
