ARTICLE III

In consideration of the Trustee's efforts, the Settlors agree to pay to the Trustee a commission equal to ten (10%) percent of the gross sales price of each sale. The Settlors further agree to pay to Trustee a commission of three (3%) percent of all amounts collected after down-payment. The Trustee is further entitled to receive three (3%) of all rents collected for Settlors. The balance of the gross sales price shall be distributed for the Settlor's portion of the expenses of sale and then to the Settlors in their respective interests.

ARTICLE IV

The Settlors agree to guarantee and secure good, marketable fee simple title for the Trustee: and prospective purchasers.

ARTICLE V

This Trust Agreement shall extend for a period of three (3) years from date with right of renewal for subsequent terms subject to the consent of the parties.

ARTICLE VI

The Trust property hereinabove referred to is as follows:
