A one-half undivided interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, southwest of the Town of Simpsonville and on or near Neely Ferry Poad, known as the Hanna Richardson place, which is more particularly described as follows: Commencing at an iron pin on the northwest side of a branch approximately ten chains northwest of its intersection with an old road, where an old fence line meets the branch, thence N 84  $k^{\circ}$  E 12.5 chains along the fence line to a bend in the fence; thence turning and running S 81 3/4° E 14.73 chains to a cresoted pole; thence turning and running S 21° W 14.76 chains to an iron pin; thence turning and running S 86 4° W 2.5 chains to an iron pin; thence turning and running S 86 3/4° W 9.66 chains to an iron pin; thence turning and running S 15 3/4° W 10.5 chains to an iron pin; thence turning and running S 79 3/4° W 4.4 chains to an iron pin in or adjacent to the aforementioned old road; thence turning and running first along the old road and then along the branch to the point of beginning, with the following courses and distances from the pin in or adjacent to the road to the point of beginning: N 8  $3/4^{\circ}$  F, 1.88 chains; N 11° E, 3.0 chains; N 7 5° E, 4.0 chains; N 3° W, 3.10 chains; N 22 3° W, 1.85 chains; N 7 3° W, 2.05 chains; N 25° W, 2.0 chains; N 9° E, 1.0 chains; N 24 4° W, 3.40 chains; N 54 4° W, 1.20 chains; and N 27° W, 3.27 chains.

Said tract is bounded on the north by lands now or formerly of Jno. D. Richardson; on the east by lands now or formerly of L. L. Martin; on the south by lands now or formerly of Dr. Martin; and on the west by lands now or formerly of J.D. Richardson along the aforementioned road and branch.

Richardson estate by S.G. Anderson & Son dated September 10, 1917, and resurveyed as shown on plat prepared by John C. Billingsley, L.S., dated November 1962; and said property is described on the 1982 Greenville County tax maps as parcel 566.02-01-007.00.
