TRUST AGREEMENT

this trust agreement made this 9th day of April, 1984, by and between Ruth Ellen Clayton, Edith Seay, Floy Sloan, Effic Stewart, and Ina Kemp, all of Greenville, South Carolina (hereinafter called "Settlors"), and Arden J. Stewart, Greenville, South Carolina (hereinafter called the "Trustee").

- transfer, assign, convey and quitclaim to the Trustee, and to his successors in trust, the property described in Schedule A attached hereto or to pay into the trust the equivalent value of their share in the property, to have and to hold such property and any other property of any kind which the Trustee may at any time hereafter hold or acquire pursuant to any of the provisions hereof (all of which property is hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Trust Estate"), subject to the trust, purposes and conditions hereinafter set forth.
- Dispositive Provisions. During the lifetime of Thomas Porrester who is now ninety-two (92) years of age and his wife, Lillie C. Forrester, who is eighty-six (86) years of age, the Trustee shall pay from the Trust Estate and/or any income therefrom for the medical and medication expenses incurred by either Thomas Porrester and/or Lillie C. Porrester which are not otherwise paid for by any other funds, state, private or insurance, or otherwise, and the Trustee shall also pay any other expenses incurred by Thomas Forrester and/or Lillie C. Porrester as the Settlors may jointly request of the Trustee. If at any time or times Thomas Forrester and/or Lillie C. Porrester are now or later come under a legal disability, or by reason of illness or mental or physical disability are, in the opinion of the Trustee, unable to manage their affairs, the Trustee shall use so much or all of the income and principal of the Trust Estate to pay for their medical expenses and medication expenses in such manner as he deems best, for the care, support and confort of Thomas Forrester and Lillie C.
