

thence running 84 E. 262 to a stake 3X; thence running N. 37 E. 3.60 to a stake 3X; thence running N. 53 W. 7.77 to stone 3X cm.; thence running S. 14½ W. 12.53 to a stake 3X, the beginning corner.

The above described property is the same conveyed to Andrew P. Hawkins by C. H. McGee by deed dated December 12, 1919, and recorded on January 23, 1920, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 55, Page 193. The said Andrew P. Hawkins died intestate in Richland County, S. C., on or about June, 1958, leaving as his sole heirs at law his ten children, Wister R. Hawkins, Hervin Hawkins, Conwell Hawkins, James B. Hawkins, Mary H. Whitfield, Congress Hawkins, Daisy H. Boyd, Andrew Hawkins, Grace H. Briggs, and Robert Isaac Hawkins, and the said Andrew Hawkins, son of Andrew P. Hawkins died on April 5, 1973, deed his interest, the same being a one-tenth undivided interest, to the grantor herein, Conwell Hawkins, as appears by deed recorded on October 14, 1974, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 1003, Page 418, thereby giving the grantor herein the one-tenth interest that he inherited from his father and the one-tenth interest that he purchased from his brother, thus constituting the one-fifth interest herein conveyed.
