ALL of our right, title and interest in and to that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Butler Township, in the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the south side of Lowndes Hill Road, being known and designated as Lot No. 4 of the property of H.
