and all forms relating to Medicare, Medicaid, or other government or private health plans.

- 4. To invest and reinvest, from time to time, and as often as she may deem advisable, any and all funds and/or properties which I may own or in which I have any interest. In making investments, my attorney may invest in stocks, bonds, etc., and she shall not be limited to investments authorized by law for trust funds, but may exercise his judgment without regard to such restrictions and without liability for mistakes of judgment when made in good faith.
- 5. To borrow any sum or sums of money on such terms and with such security, whether real or personal property, as my attorney may think fit, and for that purpose to execute all promissory notes, bonds, mortgages and any other instrument or instruments, of any kind and nature whatsoever, which he may deem necessary and proper.
- 6. To vote in person or by proxy any stock owned by me at any and all stockholders' meetings, and to execute powers of attorney authorizing another to vote by proxy.
- 7. To participate in any plan for the refunding or readjustment of any bonds or other securities, or for the enforcement of any obligation by foreclosure or otherwise, or in any corporate consolidations or reorganizations, which may affect any of the property which I own, or in any plan or proceedings therefor, for the protection of the holders of such securities,
