limit or restrict and is not intended to be or interpreted as limiting or restricting the general powers herein granted to said attorney in fact;

- 7. This power of attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing her own estate; and
- 8. The rights, powers, and authority of said attorney in fact herein granted shall commence and be in full force and effect on March 30, 1984, and such rights, powers and authority shall remain in full force and effect thereafter until termination by me to my attorney in fact which termination notice shall be recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County.
