NOTICE OF MERGER

A certificate was issued today making effective, as of 10:00 A.M., EDT, October 21, 1967, the merger of Farmers Bank of Simpsonville, Simpsonville, South Carolina, with common stock of \$135,000, into The Peoples National Bank, Greenville, South Carolina (Charter No. 10635), with common stock of \$1,650,000. The merger was effected under the charter and title of "The Peoples National Bank," with authorized capital stock of \$1,987,750, divided into 397,550 shares of common stock of the par value of \$5.00 each, with 347,550 shares issued and outstanding.

A certificate was also issued today authorizing the receiving association to operate the ten branches of The Peoples National Bank which were authorized by this office since February 25, 1927.

Certificates were also issued today authorizing the receiving association to establish the following branches:

102 West Curtis Street, Simpsonville, Greenville County, South Carolina (present location of the head office of Farmers Bank of Simpsonville), to be known as "Simpsonville Branch." Certificate No. 10619A.

104 South Main Street, Mauldin, Greenville County, South Carolina (present location of the branch of Farmers Bank of Simpsonville), to be known as "Mauldin Branch." Certificate No. 10620A.

It is understood that the receiving association and its branches will open for business on October 23, 1967.
