- 7. To refrain from voting or to vote shares of stock owned by me at shareholders' meetings in person or by proxy;
- 8. To institute, prosecute, defend, abandon, compromise, arbitrate, and dispose of legal, equitable, or administrative hearings, actions, suits, attachments, arrests, distresses or other proceedings, or otherwise engage in litigation involving me, my property or any interest of mine;
- 9. To deal with Attorney in Attorney's individual, or any fiduciary capacity, in buying and selling assets, in lending and borrowing money, and in all other transactions, irrespective of the occupancy by the same person of dual positions;
- 10. To insure my property against damage or loss and Attorney against liability with respect to third persons;
- C. 1. In general, and in addition to all the specific acts in this section enumerated, to do any other act or acts, which I can do through an agent, for the welfare of my spouse, children and/or dependents or for the preservation and maintenance of my other personal relationships to parents, relatives, friends and organizations.
- 2. To do all acts necessary for maintaining the customary standard of living of my spouse, children, and/or dependents of mine;
- 3. To continue the discharge of my services or duties assumed by me prior to the creation of this power or thereafter, to any parent, relative or friend of mine;
- 4. To supervise, compromise, enforce, arbitrate, defend or settle any claim by or against me arising out of my property damages or personal injuries suffered by or caused by me, or
