

This conveyance is made subject to an easement for a sewer line of the City of Greer located generally along or in close proximity to the northerly and northeasterly lines of the within described property (shown on said plat as being bounded by the lands of Terry and Dillard), said easement being ten (10) feet in width, measuring five (5) feet on each side of the center line of said sewer line

This conveyance is made subject to a reservation of Benjamin F. Few., Jr. and Elizabeth Few Penfield, their heirs and assigns, across the property hereby conveyed, for an easement and right of way ten (10) feet in width for the purpose of installing at any future time and thereafter maintaining a sewer line connecting with the aforementioned sewer line of the City of Greer to serve any or all of the property of Benjamin F. Few, Jr. and Elizabeth Few Penfield adjoining the property hereby conveyed, but in exercising their rights hereunder, Benjamin F. Few, Jr. and Elizabeth Few Penfield shall install said sewer line only an such location and in such manner as will not interfere with any Buildings constructed upon the property hereby conveyed.
