All that piece, parcel and lot of land located in Greenville County, State of South Carolina known and designated as Lots Numbers 3 & 4 as shown on a plat recorded in Book 11, page 159 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, State of South Carolina showing property of Susan Fortune near Greenville made by W. J. Riddle, August of 1949 as follows:

Beginning at a point on the western side of Highway 29 (now Green Avenue) and running thence along the Western side of said Highway North 33-32 East across the front of Lots 3 & 4 140.9 ft. to corner of Lot 3 on Fortune Street; thence along Fortune Street 77.5 ft to a point on an alley thence along the rear of Lot 3 42.2 ft to the rear corner of Lots 3 & 4; thence along the rear of Lot 3 & Lot 4 99.5 ft to a point along the boundary of Dunean Mill Village property; thence running said property line along the western line of Lot 4 South 29-27 East 89.2 ft to the beginning corner.
