

TRACT 1: ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, with any and all improvements thereon, lying, being and situate on Old Appalachian Highway, in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 1.79 acres, more or less, and being shown and designated as Lot No. 2 on a plat for John E. Henson, by A. G. McMurry, dated July 15, 1953, and recorded in Plat Book FFF at Page 104 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a tack in Old Appalachian Highway, and running thence N. 14-05 E. 216.7 feet to an iron pin in the North Carolina - South Carolina State line; thence running with said State line S. 85-50 E. 61.6 feet to an iron pin in the Old Southern Railroad roadbed; thence with the line of said Old Southern Railroad roadbed S. 74-50 E. 300 feet to a stake at the corner of Lot No. 1; thence with the line of Lot No. 1 S. 19-18 W. 211.5 feet to a point in Old Appalachian Highway; thence along said Highway N. 77-40 W. 353.1 feet to the point of BEGINNING.
