powers and duties shall be exercised and performed upon a majority of the total vote of the board, except as otherwise provided in the Declaration or these by-laws, such powers and duties to include but not be limited to the following:

- a. Employment of the Manager, as provided in the Declaration.
- b. Discharge of the Manager, as provided in the Declaration.
- c. Election of officers.
- d. Approval of plans for repair, reconstruction or rebuilding, as provided in the Declaration.
- e. Proposal and approval of amendments to the Declaration as provided therein.
- f. Approval of amendments to the by-laws, as provided herein.
- g. Obtaining insurance as provided in Article IX of the Declaration.

ARTICLE IV.

(Powers and Duties of Officers)

- 1. MANAGER. The Board of Directors, as soon as is resonably possible after the first election of directors, shall employ a person or corporation professionally competent in property management to serve as Manager of the Association, such employment to be authorized by vote of a majority of the whole board. The Manager shall be paid such compensation as shall be determined by vote of a majority of the whole board (all or a portion of which compensation may be in the form of use of a residence owned or controlled by the Association), and shall hold office until discharged by vote of a majority of the whole board.
- 2. <u>ELECTED OFFICERS</u>. The Board of Directors, by vote of a majority of the whole board, shall elect annually from the membership of the Association a President and a Vice-President, each of whom shall be a director, together with a Secretary and an Assistant Secretary, which officers or any of them may be removed at any meeting by vote of a majority of the whole board. No person may hold more than one such office at the same time. Such officers shall serve without compensation.
