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of the assisted living quarters and the skilled nursing care facility which will be available to those active residents who begin experiencing declining health.

J. E. Sirrine developed the master plan based upon two distinct development approaches. The central core facility will house the medical and supportive facilities while the perimeter area will be developed with independent living quarters.

Appropriate on-site supportive and recreational facilities are planned. A more complete description of the plan is as follows:

CENTRAL CORE FACILITY

The central core facility will serve as the "hub" of all activity in the project. Current plans propose that the core facility be constructed over two phases, totaling an estimated 240,000 square feet of building space. Although architectural plans are not complete, the following is a breakdown of the proposed uses in the core facility:
