- To Deposit Monies, Withdraw, Invest, etc. To deposit any monies which may come to my attorney's hands as such attorney with any bank or banker in my name, and any of such money or any other money to which I am entitled which now is or shall be so deposited to withdraw, and either employ as my attorney shall think fit in the payment of any debts, or interest, payable by me, or taxes, assessments, insurance, and expenses due and payable or to become due and payable on account of my real and personal estate, or in or about any of the purposes herein mentioned, or otherwise for my use and benefit, or to invest in my name in any stocks, shares, bonds, notes, securities, partnership interests, or other property, real or personal, as my attorney may think proper, and to receive and give receipts for any income or dividend arising from such investments, and all and any such investments or other investments to vary or dispose of for my use and benefit as my attorney may think fit. To sign checks and make withdrawals on any bank or savings and loan account or against any certificate of deposit, and to enter any safe deposit box.
- 10. To Borrow Money, Mortgage, etc. To borrow any sum of money on such terms and with such security, whether real or personal property, as my attorney may think fit, and for that purpose to execute all promissory notes, bonds, mortgages, and other instruments which may be necessary or proper.
- 11. To Carry on or Wind up Business. To carry on or to wind up any business, and in connection therewith to use the premises in which the same is or shall be carried on, with the same powers of dealing with stock, capital, and effects, and of entering our business engagements, of increasing and diminishing capital, and generally of transacting the affairs of the said business as I, myself, have or should have.
- 12. To Engage and Dismiss Agents, etc. To engage, employ, and dismiss any agents, clerks, servants, or other persons in and about the performance of these presents as my attorney shall think fit.
