- 13. To Vote at Stockholders' Meetings, etc. To vote at the meetings of stockholders or other meetings of any corporation or company, or otherwise to act as my attorney or proxy in respect to any stocks, shares, or other instruments now or hereafter held by me therein, and for that purpose to execute any proxies or other instruments.
- 14. To Exercise Fiduciary Powers so Far as May be Delegated. To exercise any powers and any duties vested in me, whether solely or jointly, with any other or others as executor, administrator, or trustee or in any other fiduciary capacity, so far as such power or duty is capable of being validly delegated.
- 15. To Execute Deeds, Bills, Notes, etc. For all or any of the purposes of these presents to enter into and sign, seal, execute, acknowledge, and deliver any contracts, deeds, or other instruments whatsoever, and to draw, accept, make, endorse, discount, or otherwise deal with any bills of exchange, checks, promissory notes, or other commercial or mercantile instruments.
- 16. To Pay Household Expenses. To pay every month the sum required to meet my ordinary household expenses.
- 17. To File Income Tax Returns and Declarations. To prepare, sign and file an Income Tax Return or Declaration of Estimated Tax elected to be filed under the Internal Revenue Code or South Carolina Code of Laws for any taxable year during the period this Power of Attorney continues to be in effect. Also, to represent me before any office of the Internal Revenue Service or South Carolina Tax Commission with respect to any and all tax matters and any and all years or periods. To receive confidential information and to have full power to perform, on my behalf, the following acts with respect to any matter as to which this Power of Attorney shall apply:
 - (i) To receive, and to endorse and collect, checks in payment of any refund of taxes, penalties, or interest;
