It is acknowledged by the undersigned that the property described below has been on the 19th day of December, 1984, posted as security for a bail bond filed in the United States District Court to secure the appearance of Frank Sullivan, and it is further understood that until such time as the surety is exonerated a lien exists against the property for the amount of the bond pledged.

In consideration of the United States District Court allowing this property to be posted as bond, the undersigned agrees:

1. To pay, prior to becoming delinquent, all taxes, assessments, dues and charges of every kind imposed or levied upon the real property described below; and
2. Without the prior written consent of the United States District Court for the District of South Carolina, to refrain from creating or permitting any lien or other encumbrance (other than those presently existing) to exist on, and from transferring, selling, assigning or in any manner disposing of, the real property described below, or any interest therein.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the Laurel Creek section of the County and State aforesaid containing one (1) acre, more or less, and being the southerly portion of a larger tract of the grantor herein, and the metes and bounds set out in a survey performed by R. K. Campbell, R.L.S., dated March 19, 1962.

This is the same property previously conveyed to grantor by deed of Elsie Bell Burnside filed in the RMC Office for Greenville County, SC on April 14, 1962, in Book 696 at page 260.

NOTE: GRANTOR IS THE DIRECT HEIR OF ALEXANDER W. SULLIVAN, IN WHOSE NAME THE ABOVE DEED IS TITLED.

3. That the United States Government is hereby authorized and permitted to cause this instrument to be recorded at such time and in such places as the United States Government, in its discretion, may elect, with the expenses of recording to be borne by the defendant, or by the undersigned surety(ies) on the bond.
