## 1. PROPERTY NO. 1

2601 Galleria Drive Arlington, Texas 76010

Being a tract or parcel of land situated in the City of Arlington, Tarrant County, Texas; and being Site 25, a tract of land out of part of the J. H. THENCE North 26° 41' 35" West along the easterly line of State Highway 360 a distance of 48.99 feet to the beginning of a curve to the right;

THENCE in a northerly direction along the easterly line of State Highway 360 and along said curve to the right having a radius of 453.26 feet, a central angle of 24° 05' 42", and an arc length of 190.61 feet to a point for corner in the southerly line of Great Southwest Railroad Load Track No. Two;

THENCE North 83° 55' 20° East along the southerly line of said Load Track No. Two a distance of 124.39 feet to an angle point;

THENCE due East continuing along the southerly line of said Load Track No. Two a distance of 254.98 feet to a point for corner;

THENCE due South a distance of 190.0 feet to a point for corner;

THENCE due West a distance of 21.0 feet to a point for corner;

THENCE due South a distance of 50.0 feet to a point for corner in the north line of Galleria Drive;

THENCE due West along the north line of Galleria Drive a distance of 287.83 feet to the PLACE OF BEGINNING and containing 83,325 square feet, more or less, or 1.9129 Acres.
